# PEOSTA PARKS AND RECREATION 2023 COED FALL LEAGUES INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION

#### TEAM ROSTER DEADLINE:

Team applications and rosters are due by Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm at the Peosta Community Centre, located at 7896 Burds Road. Any registrations that come in after the deadline will be placed on a waiting list.

#### TEAM FEE:

The team fee is \$125. Please make checks payable to the Peosta Community Centre.

#### TEAM ROSTER INFORMATION & ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. All players must be 18 years of age and out of high school this past year. Staff may question the age of any player and that player must be able to produce a form of identification that will prove their age. Failure to do so will prohibit the player from playing until age is legally proven.
- 2. Rosters must be printed in ink. All information must be filled out for each player and be correct. Any roster which is not filled out correctly, will be sent back to be completed correctly.
- 3. If a players' name appears on more than 1 roster, the team in which the player participates with **first**, is the team that player is legally on.
- 4. Roster additions must be made to the league director prior to any new players playing. Please call Stacey at 556-8751 for approval.
- 5. Rosters must have a minimum of 12 players and a maximum of 20 players.

## **TEAM SELECTION PROCESS:**

1. First 12 teams that turn in roster, waiver and \$125. All three must be turned in together.

#### CAPTAINS MEETING:

Each team must be represented at the captain's meeting. The meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup> at 6:00pm at the Peosta Community Centre. Game schedules, umpire schedules and rules will be passed out at this time. League fees must be paid prior to the captain's meeting.

### **CAPTAINS:**

Please fill out the team roster and the team waiver and turn it into the Peosta Community Centre by Friday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. Each player must sign the waiver form before they are eligible to play.

### **RULES OF INTEREST:**

- 1. All teams will hit their own softballs. Balls must be ASA approved, 12 inch, <u>.52 cor and be 300 pounds compression</u>.
- 2. The mat will be used in all games to call balls and strikes. If any part of the ball hits the plate or the mat, it is a strike. All batters will start with a 1 and 1 count.
- 3. All balls hit over the fence after the homerun limit will result in an out.
- 4. Teams must have 8 players to start the game, 4 females and 4 males.
- 5. The batting order must alternate male and female or vice versa. Teams cannot have 6 or more males playing at one time.
- 6. There is a 5-minute grace period before the start of each game to field 8 players. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit.
- 7. If a team forfeits twice, their status will be reviewed by the League Director and the team may be suspended from the league.
- 8. We recommend each team have matching shirts with numbers.
- 9. **No swearing.** The first offense will be a team warning; the second offense will be an ejection from the game.
- 10. Teams can start with one more male than female. The 10 batter will result in an out.
- 11. With less than 2 outs, after every base on balls to a male batter, the male batter receives a 2nd base award and the female batter must bat. When there are 2 outs, the female has the option of taking the at-bat or taking a walk and the male receives a 2 base award.
- 12. When a female is at-bat, all outfielders must position themselves beyond the 185' arc until the ball is hit. This should be an honor call by the players, since it is difficult for the umpire to see it.
- 13. Each team must provide two players to umpire when noted on the umpire schedule. Failure to provide an umpire will result in a \$25.00 fine. An umpire schedule will be passed out with the game schedules.
- 14. Run Rule: 15 after 4 innings, 10 after 5 innings
- 15. Time Limit: No inning will start after 55 minutes for regular season.
- 16. A full game is considered 7 innings.
- 17. ASA Approved bats only.

### LEAGUE PLAY:

Games will be held on Thursday nights starting on August 10<sup>th</sup> and finish in September. The season will consist of approximately 8 games with a season ending, single-elimination tournament.
