At completion, Kelly Oaks Park will be an zero entry accessible park with a playground, disc golf course, open green space, indoor/outdoor pavilion for picnicking or hosting events, and a multi-use trail loop.

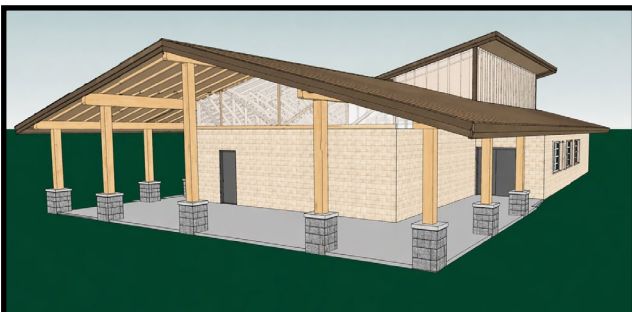

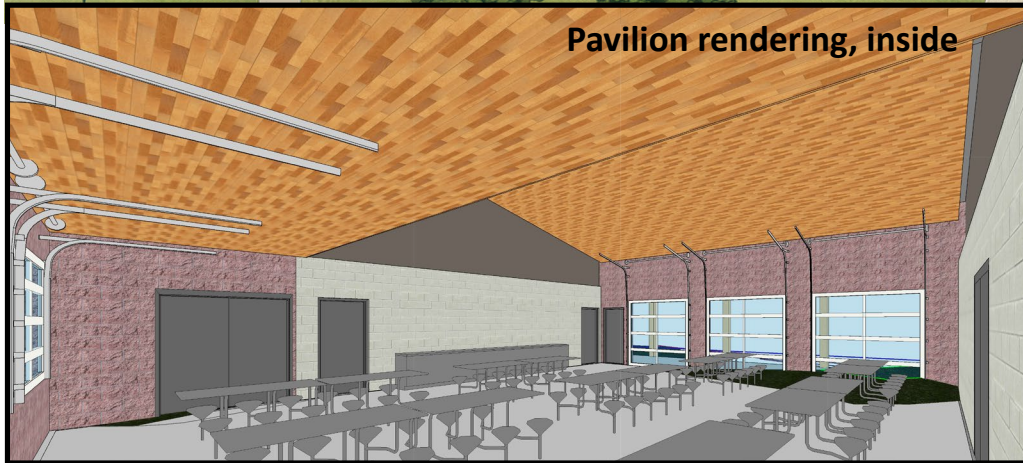
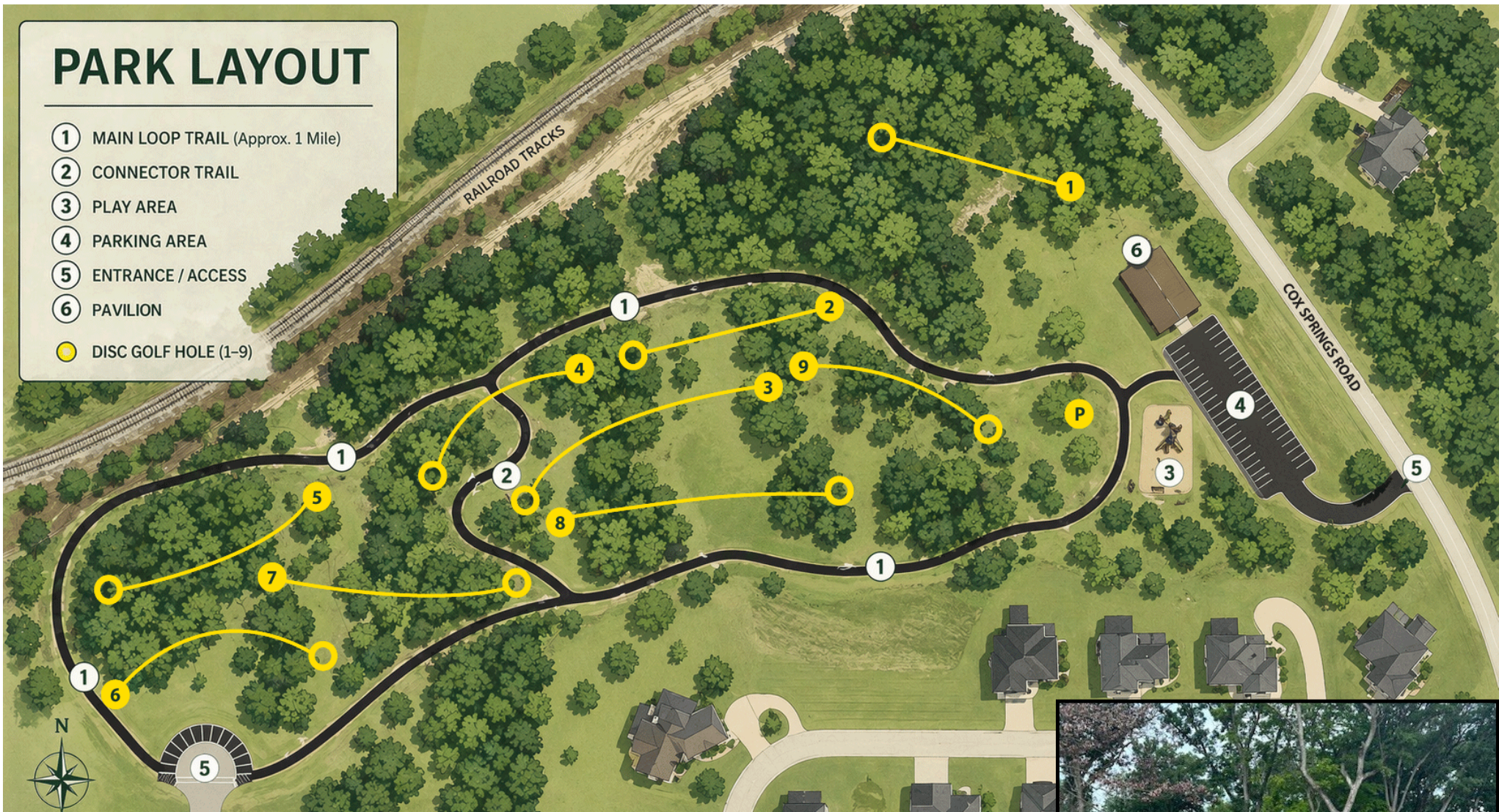
