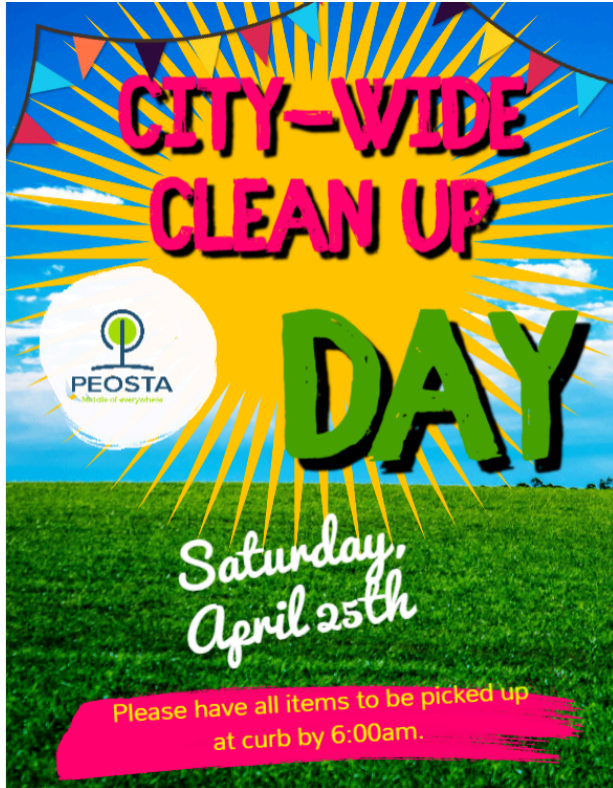

Truck Tires: \$12.00

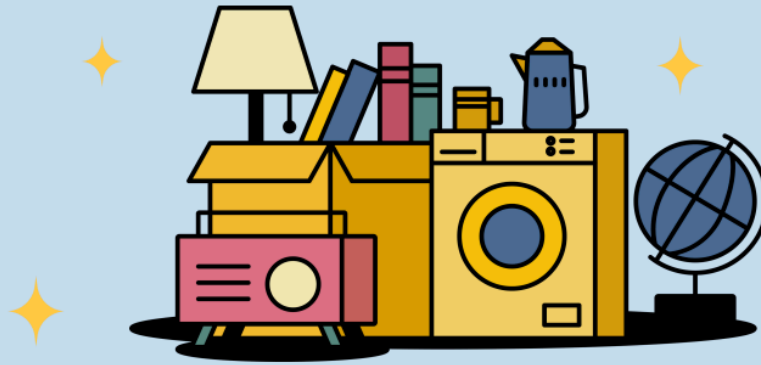
Tractor Tires: \$27.00
