Join the Board of Adjustment (BOA)

The City of Peosta has an opening on our Board of Adjustments (BOA) for a five-year term. The BOA meets on an as needed basis to review the following:

A Friendly Reminder for Dog Owners

Please be mindful when walking your dog through the City. It is great to see Pet owners and pups out and about enjoying the beautiful weather. Please remember to maintain control of your pup.

Code of Ordinances 4-1-1 (2) 2.

The term "at large" shall mean any licensed or unlicensed animal found off the premises of the owner and not under the control of a competent person, restrained within a motor vehicle, housed in a veterinary hospital or kennel, on a leash or "at heel" beside a competent person and obedient to that person's command.

Appeals From Administrative Official: To hear and decide appeals where it is alleged there is error in any order, requirement, decision, or determination made by an administrative official in the enforcement of any ordinance adopted pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 414, as such may be amended from time to time.

Conditional Uses: To hear and decide applications for conditional use permits upon which such board is required to pass under the provisions of this title.

Variances: To authorize upon appeal in specific cases such variance from the bulk regulation provisions of this title, parking and sign requirements of this title as will not be contrary to the public interest, where owing to special conditions a literal enforcement of these provisions will result in unnecessary hardship, and so that the spirit of these provisions shall be observed, and substantial justice done.

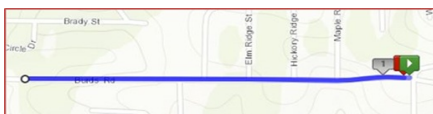
Special Exceptions: To hear and decide applications for special exceptions to the terms of this title, in accordance with the general regulations of the zone in which the property is located and specific standards contained herein.

The vacancy will remain open until October 12th, at which time the mayor will make a recommendation to appoint at the October 25th council meeting.

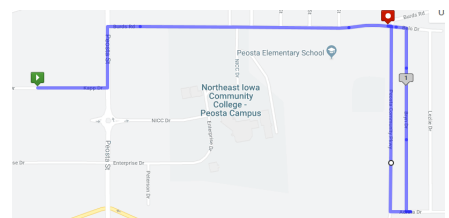

Kids Fun Run Road Closure

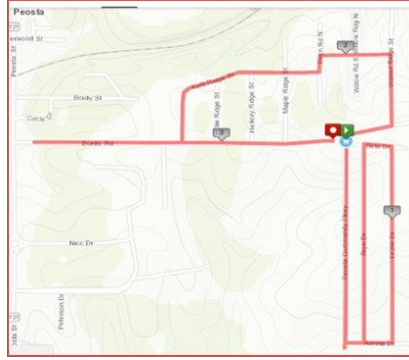
