Our journey to create a unified vision for Peosta started on January 30th when we unveiled the Peosta Dream Board at our Perspectives – Possibilities – Promise event. Since then additional ideas have been added, but July 30th marked the start of the next phase.

We had our first public work session with a company called RDG. They are a planning and design firm with roots firmly here in Iowa and an office in Dubuque. They are also active in similar work with Dyersville, they are currently helping Dubuque County create their Master Parks, Trails, and Open Spaces Plan, and they completed Peosta's housing study earlier this year.

Over the next 10-12 months we will build a Comprehensive Plan and Master Parks and Trails Plan that is designed around the input we receive from all our resident, business, and education stakeholders – That is YOU! This document will detail our vision for a future Peosta and provide a plan for us to actually make it a reality.

We will have several more of these highly interactive events which are essential for us to build a vision that addresses our unique wants and needs. I encourage you to bookmark www.peostaplan.com. 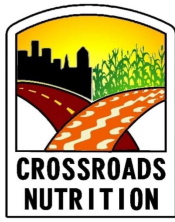
We try our best to reach as many people as possible through multiple channels, but it is an ongoing challenge. Please talk about this with your friends and family so we can engage as many perspectives as possible!
