

## **GLASS**

Only clear, green, or brown containers that held food or beverages are recyclable. Please rinse containers and remove the lids. Do not break the glass. Metal jar lids can be recycled with metal cans.

# CARDBOARD/PAPER

Acceptable materials are books, carbonless forms, catalogs, <u>clean</u> pizza boxes, corrugated cardboard, beer and soda boxes, envelopes, gray cardboard, tissue roll cores, junk mail, magazines, newspapers, office paper, paper egg cartons, and phone books.

No paper towels, tissues, napkins, paper plates, diapers or sanitary products!

### METAL

Rinse all metal containers. Acceptable materials are aluminum foil, beverage cans, metal jar lids in flattened cans, pie pans, rinsed food containers, and screw top jar lids.

#### PLASTIC

Check the bottom of the containers for the recycling symbol and number. Number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 7 are accepted. No Number 6! Please rinse all containers. Acceptable materials are bleach bottles, cooking oil containers, dish soap bottles, household cleaning bottles, laundry soap bottles, lotion bottles, margarine or ice cream tubs, milk and juice jugs, soda and water bottles, shampoo bottles, yogurt cups, food wrap, plastic bags and Tupperware. Remember that every item must have a number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7!
