JOB DESCRIPTION

Title: Seasonal Snow Plow Operator

PURPOSE: Under general supervision from the Public Works Director performs semi-skilled and skilled work involving the operation of snow plow trucks and pickups

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

Operates trucks used in hauling materials and supplies

Operates truck equipped with snow plow and sander for snow and ice removal from City streets and parking lots

QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge and Professional Certification: Requires a high school diploma, GED or equivalent. Considerable knowledge of the operation and general mechanical functions of trucks, specialized construction equipment and heavy equipment; knowledge of potential operating hazards and of applicable safety precautions

Skill to adjust to changing situations, priorities and deadlines while maintaining efficiency and effectiveness; ability to make minor adjustments and repairs on equipment used

HUMAN RELATIONS: Ability to establish and to maintain an effective working relationship with supervisors, state, county and municipal elected officials, employees at all levels within the organization and members of the community; ability to interact constructively with the general public; ability to understand and follow both written and oral instructions;

MINIMUM JOB RELATED EXPERIENCE:

Requires minimum two years of experience in construction, earthwork, operation and maintenance of trucks and heavy equipment, or an equivalent combination of education and experience

WORKING CONDITIONS: Operates equipment with varying degrees of noise and vibration; requires an on call regular basis to perform snow plowing operations in all kinds of weather conditions during day and night hours; requires availability on a call in basis

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be able to step up 18 inches into employers' equipment

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: For those tasks where personal or City vehicle is used, individual must be physically capable of operating the vehicle safely. Requires possession of

a valid Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with air brakes and is subject to the Department of Transportation drug and alcohol testing program.
