Community Park Vision

The Kelly Oaks Park is a community project that is a venue to bring residents together as a community. The goals of the projects are to build a structure that creates a community identity, is a centerpiece for the city, is a visible presence in the community main stream, is sustainable, improves space needs issues and adds cultural opportunities to our park system.

The City of Peosta Values

The City of Peosta believes in fostering a high-quality community where people live, learn, grow, work and play - the kind of place that people want to call "home".

Peosta values nature and open space, cultural and recreational opportunities, along with safe community living. We pride ourselves in the development of parks and trails and most recently the development of a public library.

As the community of Peosta grows, so too must the parks.

Goals Fulfilled by This Project

- The City of Peosta leaders conducted a community visioning session in 2018. Their goal was to determine ways to provide a safe and productive environment for all residents, driving growth and providing superior municipal services and quality of life amenities to promote the heath, wellness, livelihood, and resiliency of Peosta and its residence. The Kelly Oaks Park shared Multi-Use Path is a result of this public engagement. In a community with essentially just one sidewalk, 87% of the respondents said that "more complete sidewalks and trails" would improve or greatly improve the quality of like in Peosta. Closely following this priority was "a new central park". Residents want their city to provide and promote a safe and equitable access to parks and recreational amenities, as a focus on safe environments so everyone has the opportunity to get outdoors and be physically active. Community members were especially excited about the following types of services and amenities.
- Greenways with trails
- Passive natural areas
- Pavilions and gathering areas
- Natural playscape
- Playgrounds

Goals Fulfilled by This Project – cont'd

• In response to the community feedback during the visioning session, a local resident donated property to the City of Peosta to create a new central park Now known as Kelly Oaks Park. The Keep Iowa Beautiful (KIB), Hometown Pride (HTP) Committee partnered with the City of Peosta to create a plan of the park, working with MSA Engineering to begin developing the park in stages. A disc golf course has already been completed as phase one amongst the trees in the center of Kelly Oaks Park. The second phase and next priority is to create the multi-use trail look around the park, which will be the catalyst for future development of an all-encompassing city-wide trail and side-walk system. Future phases to complete the centralization Kelly Oaks Park, and improve quality of life for the residents and visitors alike, will be a playground, pavilion, and larger paved parking lot.

Benefits of Park Location

- City parks and open spaces improve our physical and psychological health, strengthen our communities and make our city and neighborhoods more attractive places to live and work.
- Numerous studies have shown social, environmental, and health benefits parks bring to a city and
 its people. The Kelly Oaks Park will serve as the community hub for trail heads, disk golf, and
 recreational activities.

Life-Long Activity

• The parks' purpose is for physical activity, for family and communities to come together, or just simply to take a break from daily stressors.

Populations Served

• Incorporated in 1933, the population of the City of Peosta in 1,908 as of the 202 Census. Peosta grew from only 128 people as recently as 1990 to almost 2,000 today. This 1000% growth in 20 years is a result of Peosta's extensive experience managing grant, successfully undertaking fundraising campaigns, and implementing construction projects including two elementary schools, a hotel, church, industrial park, community center, and expanding neighborhoods. Growth projections show that Peosta's population will more than double to approximately 5,000 people in the next 25 years, requiring the City to offer a range of new amenities to residents to maintain its appeal, especially trails and parks accessible by all.

Sustainability

 Kelly Oaks Park is supported by the City of Peosta. The Commitment has been made by the city to continue to support this park now, and into the future.
